

Episode: Assisting the Elderly to Make COVID-19 Vaccination Bookings

- 0:04 Now, there is a new arrangement to assist the elderly to make COVID-19 vaccination appointment!
- 0:08 If elderly people aged 60 or above need assistance to make online reservation,
- 0:13 they can go [District Elderly Community Centres and Neighbourhood Elderly Centres](#) under the Social Welfare Department,
- 0:18 or [District Health Centres \(DHCs\) and DHC Expresses](#) under the Health Bureau for assistance.
- 0:24 [Designated Elderly Health Centres \(EHCs\)](#) under the Department of Health would provide COVID-19 vaccination service for members and non-members aged 65 years or above, as well as assisting elderly in need to make online bookings for COVID-19 vaccines which are not provided at that EHC.
- 0:40 In addition to make appointments online, the elderly can also give a direct call to the [Private Clinic COVID-19 Vaccination Stations](#) to enquire about relevant vaccination services.
- 0:47 COVID-19 vaccination can effectively prevent severe illness, members of the public should complete their initial doses in no time,
- 0:53 persons belonging to the high-risk groups should also receive booster doses to enhance protection!
